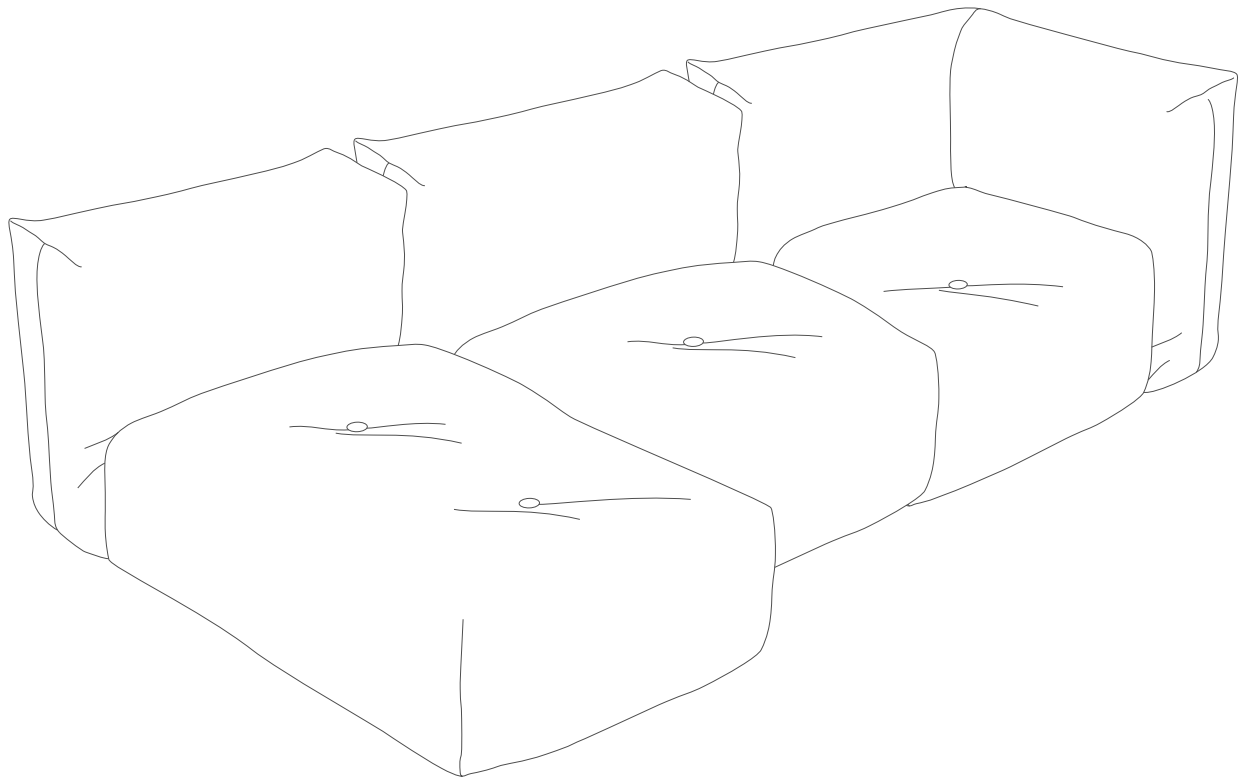

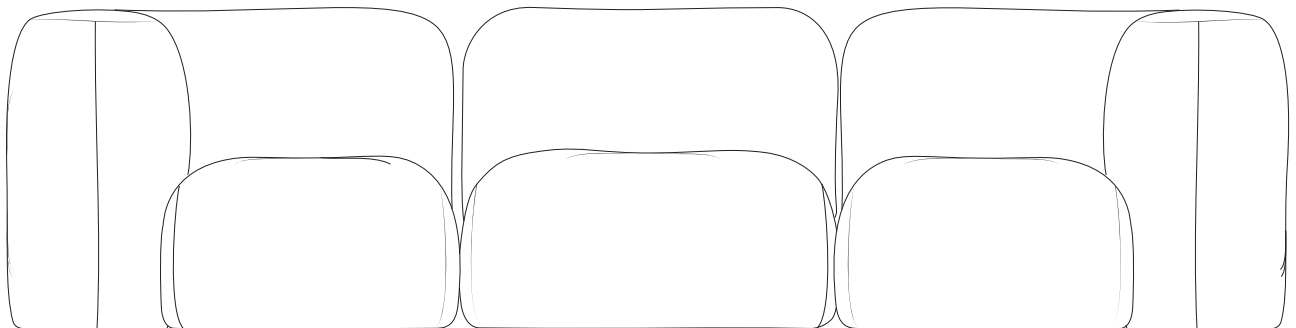

INTRODUCTION

A sofa without rules

Soft Sofa Indoor is the kind of sofa that doesn't take life too seriously. It's not too nice to be used – quite the opposite. It's made for lounging, stretching out, and living with. A sofa you can reshape, mess up a little, and make your own.

Soft Sofa Indoor is designed by SACKit's own design team, with the ambition to create a sofa that doesn't dictate how you sit. A sofa that gives you space to sprawl, twist, rebuild and use it exactly as it fits into your life. It's allowed to be a little imperfect – that's part of the charm.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

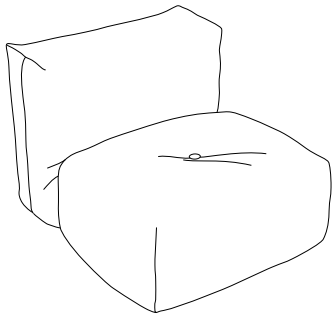
Taking care of your Soft Sofa, can extend its lifespan and preserve the quality of its foam and fabric. The following guidelines provide general advice to help you maintain your sofa's condition:

- *To prevent damage, avoid placing the sofa in direct sunlight or near heat sources. Even though the Soft Sofa is made with high-quality fabric, exposure to sunlight and heat can cause all textiles to fade and seams to weaken over time.*
- *Regular cleaning is essential to maintain the fabric's appearance. Dust and dirt can gradually wear down the material, so it's important to vacuum the sofa regularly using an upholstery nozzle. This will help remove dust and minimize fluff or pilling, keeping the fabric in good shape.*
- *The foam inside the Soft Sofa may compress slightly over time, why it is a good idea to fluff the filling regularly by gently kneading the modules.*
- *In the event of a spill, address stains as quickly as possible to avoid permanent damage. Most stains can be effectively removed by using lukewarm water and a clean, lint-free cloth. If necessary, use the SACKit Textile Cleaner or alternatively a small amount of neutral detergent, but be careful not to rub the fabric too harshly, as this can result in discoloration or damage. Refrain from using concentrated detergents, bleach, ammonia, or cleaning products designed for hard surfaces, as these can harm the fabric.*

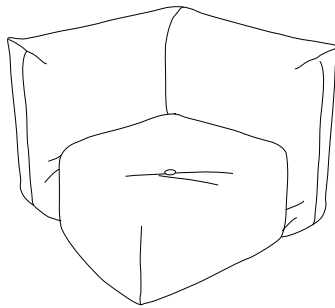
PARTS

The Soft Sofa is a modular lounge system consisting of four modules: a seat module, a corner module, a chaise lounge module, and a pouf. The flexible design allows you to arrange the modules in any configuration, making it easy to adapt the Soft Sofa to your space and needs.

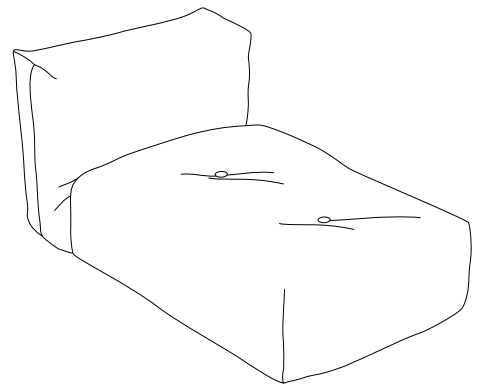

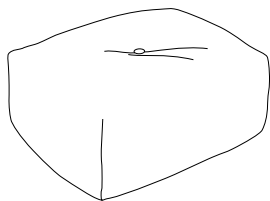
SEAT MODULE



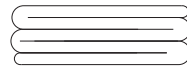
CORNER MODULE



CHAISE LOUNGE MODULE



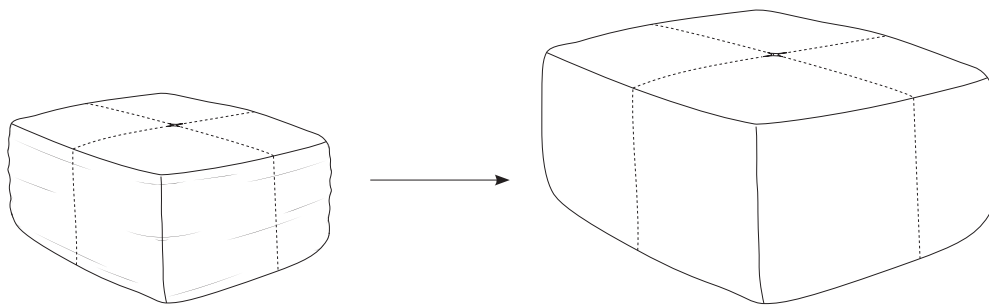

COVER

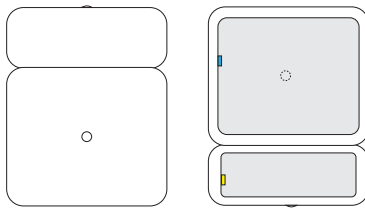
When you receive your new Soft Sofa, it will be vacuum-packed. This makes it easier to handle and is also better for the environment. Once you remove the modules from the packaging, they will begin to expand immediately. However, it takes up to 72 hours for each module to fully regain its shape and size. We recommend placing the module into its cover right after opening the packaging and allowing it to expand inside. We recommend being two people for the assembly of the modules.

During the expansion period, gently fluffing and kneading the module can help the foam distribute more evenly inside the cover.

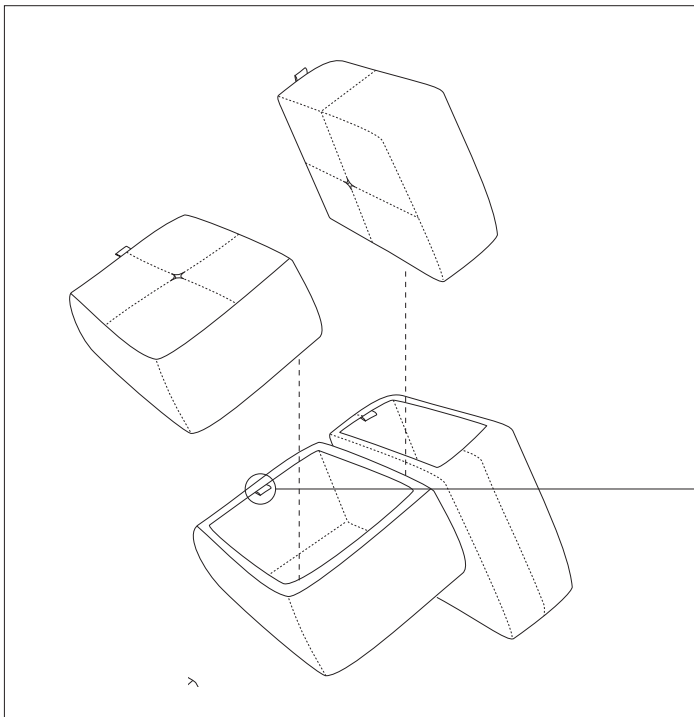
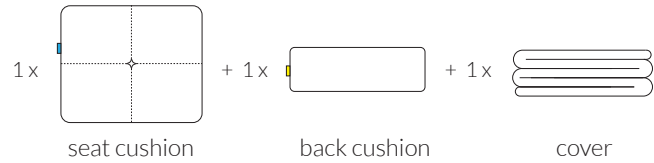

Module Seat

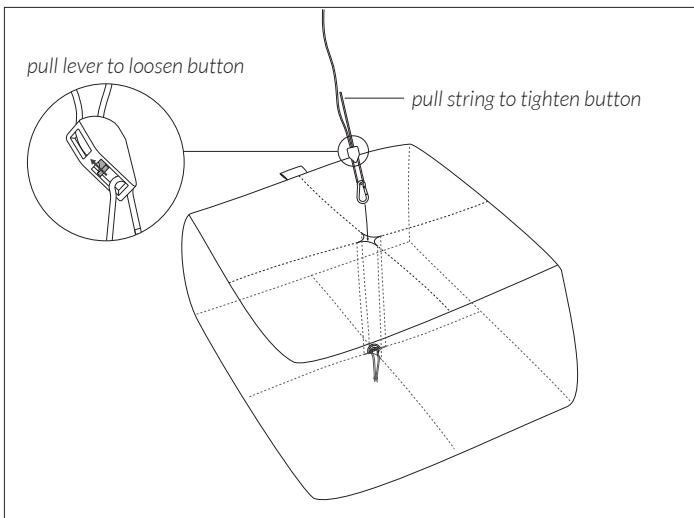
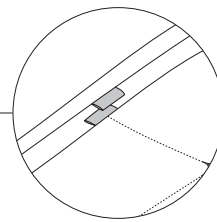

Module Corner

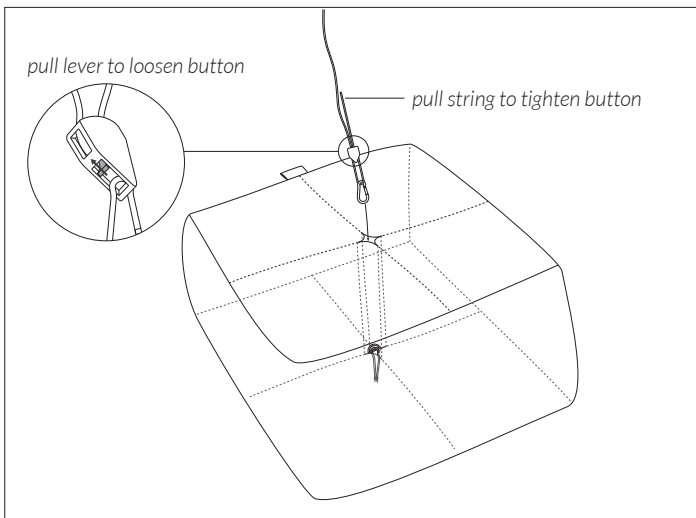

Module Chaise lounge

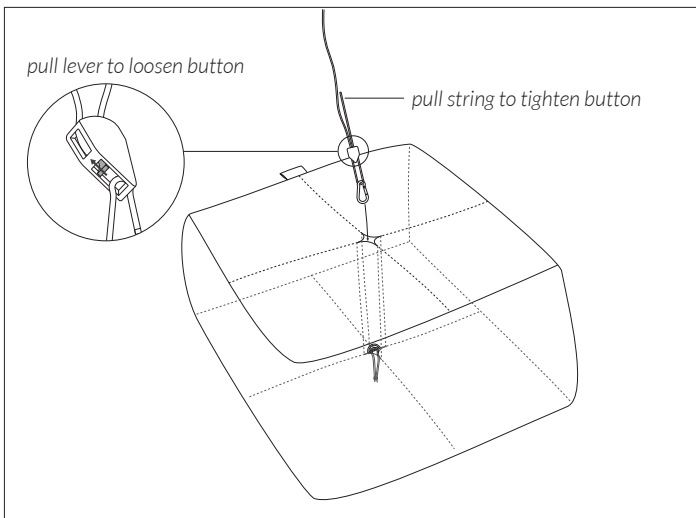
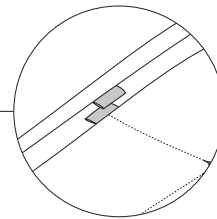

Module Pouf

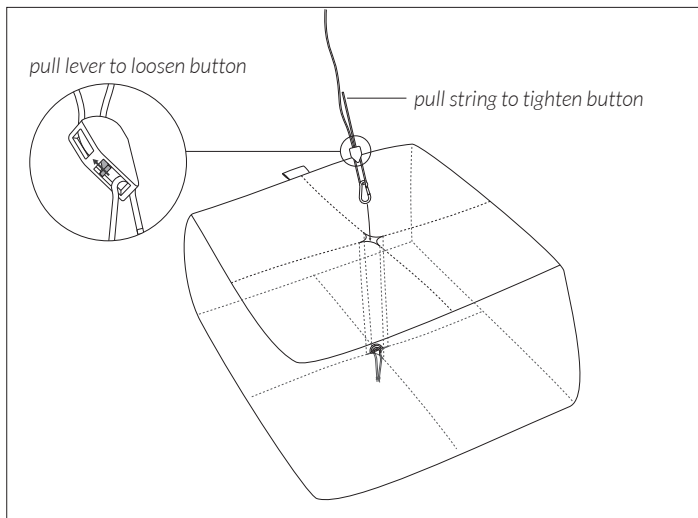
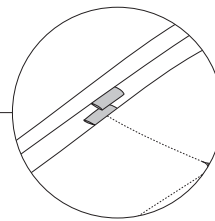
